

Dear Uwharrie Mountain Festival Participant,

The 2nd annual Uwharrie Mountain Festival will be held at King's Mountain Point in the Uwharrie National Forest, Saturday, October 13, 2007. The festival is held, rain or shine, in an open field surrounded by a wooded recreation area. The festival will be open to the public, 9am-9pm.

Vendors may arrive on site between 7-9am to set up. Each vendor is responsible for his/her setup, such as tables, chairs, tents, etc. All vendor spaces will be 10 X 15'. If your equipment, merchandise, or canopy will not fit within this space, you will need to reserve an additional space. Vehicles, including trailers that are not a direct part of a display, cannot be parked within the reserved vendor space. Parking is limited – please drive only what is necessary to transport your merchandise and setup.

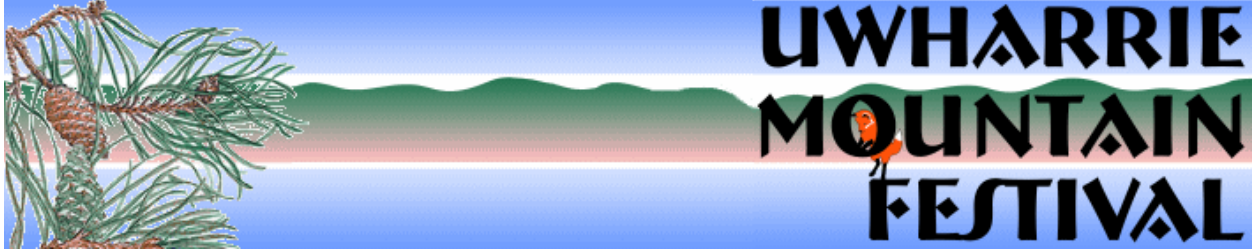
Vendors may depart at 5pm or later. The festival will continue until 9pm. Before you depart, the U.S. Forest Service requires payment of 3% of your day's gross sales if you are a for-profit entity. Checks may be made payable to the U.S. Forest Service. Due to the primitive nature of the festival location, electricity is not provided to vendors.

The mission of the festival is to showcase the culture, heritage, and resources of the Uwharrie Mountain region. Toward that end, we are seeking vendors whose merchandise is largely handcrafted, may consist of local materials, and is created in the region. Applications may be completed online or submitted by mail. Your application will not be considered for approval until we receive your vendor fee of \$25.
